GREETING TEAM

Greeters have an extremely important role here! As a greeter, you would be responsible for welcoming everyone who comes through New City's doors.

COFFEE BAR

Serving coffee on Sunday morning is much more than just handing someone a cup of coffee or a bottle of water. This is an opportunity for you to engage with our community and help people get connected.

WELCOME BAR

The Welcome Bar is the central hub for everyone on Sundays. Your primary role on this team would be to connect with guests and inform those looking for more information about the church and our events.

PRE-SERVICE SET UP

As part of the pre-services team, you would work with us to set up, clean and prepare for people to arrive before services begin, from 7–8:15 am.

POST-SERVICE CLEAN UP

The post-service clean-up team works together to break everything down and tidy up the church following our services, from approximately 12:45–1:15 pm.

HOST TEAM LEAD

As a host lead, you would oversee and direct service volunteers. Sunday mornings are busy and require a lot of coordination, so it's important for our leads to be hospitable, caring, and firm. Host leads help set a welcoming, professional tone for everyone at New City!

ADMINISTRATION TEAM

As part of the administration team, you would help after our last service on Sunday (typically from 1–2 pm) by entering information into our database.

PARKING TEAM

Help us direct traffic, ensure safety of cars and pedestrians, and welcome people when they arrive at church as part of our parking team.

SECURITY TEAM

On the security team, you would work alongside the Arizona Rangers to help maintain peace and order on Sundays, as well as at occasional special events.

ONLINE ENGAGEMENT TEAM

Help us stay engaged with our digital community on Facebook, YouTube and ChurchOnline during Sunday services. This team will also write encouraging cards during the week. It's a great way to get involved from home!

ACTIVITY COORDINATORS

As an activity coordinator, you would organize and facilitate groups to do different activities together around the city — such as hiking, volleyball, running, etc. — and build community.

EVENT COORDINATORS

Collaborate on special events with us as an events coordinator. This includes set up, greeting and clean up during events like City Life: Welcome to New City or Prayer & Worship Night.

REGISTRATION TEAM / DOOR GREETER

Registration is our first impression! As part of this team, you would welcome families with a smile, assist them with checking in their children and answer any questions.

NURSERY/TODDLER TEAM LEAD

As a nursery/toddler team lead, you get to build relationships with babies, kids and parents in the community. Responsibilities include: scheduling volunteers in your room, overseeing the drop-off and pick-up process, preparing Bible-centric activities based on the provided curriculum, and more.

PRESCHOOL TEAM

As a preschool team member, you get to help teach our preschoolers that God loves them, God made them and Jesus wants to be their friend forever through Bible stories, worship and age-appropriate activities.

K-4th MC/HOST

On this team, you would help us welcome and engage kids by delivering the weekly message in a way that's engaging, inspiring and age-appropriate. We need high-energy, driven leaders!

K-4th TEAM LEAD

As a grade-specific team lead, your responsibilities would include engaging kids on Sundays, coordinating and scheduling volunteers in your room, managing the drop-off and pick-up processes, facilitating large group time and small group activities, and more.

K-4th SMALL GROUP LEADER

As a grade-specific small group leader, you would have the opportunity to invest in the lives of our children each week in order to encourage authentic faith.

TECH TEAM

CHILDREN & FAMILIES // SAFE FAMILIES
