NURSERY

As a two-year-old team member, you will provide a safe space for our toddlers to play and explore on Sunday mornings! You'll oversee the drop-off and pick-up process, keep the little ones entertained, and build relationships with our families.

PRESCHOOL TEAM

As a preschool team member, you'll get to help teach our preschoolers that God loves them, God made them and Jesus wants to be their friend forever through Bible stories, worship and age-appropriate activities.

NEW CITY COLLEGE

HOST FAMILIES

As a host family, you are a “home away from home.” We want students to know that they are seen, heard, and valued at New City, and we ask you to join us by investing in them during this short, exciting season.

EVENT VOLUNTEERS

As an event volunteer, you will help with set up and tear down for college activities and events. This is a great way for families and other individuals at New City to get involved alongside college students and invest in their lives, even if you don't have the bandwidth to be a host family.

JUSTICE & CARE

CARE TEAM

As part of our care team, you will assist with care-related needs on Sundays — including physical, financial, spiritual, and mental wellness. You'll help connect people with resources, provide prayer, and much more. There are various roles within this team, and a background check is required.

LOVE OUR CITY

This team will help us bring the hope of Jesus and the heart of New City beyond the walls of our building. Our Love the City event will happen on a Saturday in the fall, and will be the primary on-ramp for on-going “Local Good” serving opportunities. We'll need family volunteers, service volunteers, and hands-on volunteers to do physical and technical labor.

AFFORDABLE CHRISTMAS

Affordable Christmas is a tradition at New City that helps accomplish our justice initiatives by coming alongside families and children within our Local Good Ministry Partners. We not only open our hearts with generosity to give, we also open the doors of our church and invite families to come and purchase gifts at a low cost for their families. We are looking to recruit a team of volunteers that would love to be part of organizing this event.

HUSTLE PHOENIX

Motivated by Christian faith, we encourage the creation of sustainable business ventures that affirm the dignity of people and lead to the flourishing of all communities in Phoenix. Hustle PHX believes the difference between wealth and poverty is relationships, and that's where YOU play a vital role in helping to make a difference in the lives of our entrepreneurs and the broader Phoenix community.

OHANA

Ohana creates safe, faith-based and loving family environments for foster children and adults with special needs. Many children in the foster care system age out and exit the foster care system without anyone to spend the holidays and life milestones with. We're looking for volunteers who are interested in becoming a mentor for Ohana youth as they mature into adulthood.

KENILWORTH ELEMENTARY

Kenilworth is a title IX elementary school right in our backyard. Our relationship to Kenilworth is crucial to making a long-lasting impact in the community in which we live, work, study, and play. HOPE WOMEN'S CENTER

We've partnered with Hope Women's Center – a Christian nonprofit organization that supports vulnerable women and teen girls – and will help them with various projects throughout the year. You can sign up to help us with specific service projects every month.

GROUPS

ACTIVITY COORDINATORS

As an activity coordinator, you would organize and facilitate groups to do different activities together around the city. This is a flexible time commitment and a fun way to get involved with others in our community.

GROUP HOST

If you don't want to lead a group, but still want to service our community, you can sign up to regularly host a group in your home and work with the leader to coordinate details.

GROUP LEADER

As a group leader, you would make a commitment to lead with a specific discipleship vision and build community within a small group. We ask our group leaders to go through an "on-the-job" training process before leading a group. The training includes reading about spiritual formation and facilitating a group of people in New City's discipleship experience, called Core.

PRAYER TEAM MEMBER

As a member of the prayer team, you would volunteer on a regular schedule to pray for people in our community who send in prayer requests throughout the week.

PRAYER CARD WRITER

Our prayer card writers send weekly notes of encouragement — either by email or a handwritten note — to 1-3 people who have submitted a prayer request.

WORSHIP/AV TEAM

AUDIO ENGINEER

Sign up to help us with mixing live and broadcast audio for Sunday services and various extra events.

CAMERA/VIDEO PRODUCTION

In this production role, you would assist with on-site operation of broadcast cameras for online services. You'd also help control the live-feed switcher for our online broadcasts and in-person gatherings.

MUSIC DIRECTOR

As a music director, you would assist with our week-to-week worship team scheduling and asset creation for our Sunday service graphics.

SINGER/MUSICIAN

Volunteer to join our worship team on Sundays! Whether you sing or play an instrument, we have different on-stage roles available.

GENERAL PRODUCER

As a volunteer producer, you would oversee and monitor the overall production of a Sunday service from lighting, to transitions to slides, and more.

CREATIVE/COMMUNICATIONS

PHOTO

Help us capture moments during Sunday services and special events. Volunteers with a photography background preferred because editing is part of the role.

VIDEO

Help us capture and edit video projects of services and events. Volunteers with a videography or video editing background preferred.

SOCIAL MEDIA

Assist with the content creation and management of New City social media accounts.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

Assist with design projects and branding within New City.

SUNDAY EXPERIENCE

Assist with reaching and engaging our congregation by sharing information, promoting events, passing out cards as needed, and more.

Our women's ministry is in need of event and activity planners who can coordinate community gatherings and opportunities for connection.
